The Big Picture



Achievement



- All children will make consistently good progress across a range of subjects relative to their starting points.
- We will be more precise and strategic in our provision for pupils who receive Pupil Premium funding, so that they all make at least the same progress as their peers.
- All SEN children will make good progress appropriate to their needs.

Reading



- Our teaching of phonics in Owls and Kites will ensure that phonics outcomes are consistently above national averages.
- We will further develop a love of reading in our children by using a wide range of texts in our cross curricular learning.

Maths



- We will embed the use of Maths Mastery across the school to ensure that all children make progress appropriate to their prior attainment.
- Our marking and feedback in Maths will ensure all children are clear about what they have achieved and what their next steps of learning are.

Writing



- Children's progress in writing across the school will improve so that all end of year outcomes accurately reflect children's prior attainment.
- We will ensure there is a whole school approach and consistency to joined handwriting so that our children's presentation is always excellent.
- We will develop more opportunities to write in a wide range of subjects on a regular basis and have regular opportunities to respond to feedback.

Learning



- We will have consistently high expectations of children's outcomes, progress and attitudes to learning.
- The quality of our teaching across the school will improve so that the majority of it is judged as at least good.
- We will increase the children's resilience in learning, and give them opportunities to support their lifelong learning.

Curriculum



- Our curriculum will deliver high quality learning experiences that are rich, vibrant and relevant to our children in the 21st Century.
- Our learning environments across the school will accurately reflect high quality learning and teaching, and will positively support the children's outcomes.

Early Years
