predator	An animal that naturally hunts others.
prey	An animal that is hunted and killed.
food chain	A chain where each thing is dependent on the other.
endangered	A species at risk of extinction.

Habitats



A habitat is a home environment for different plants and animals. Examples of habitats include desert, woodland, forest, ocean or the rainforest. A micro-habitat is a smaller, more specific habitat such as a pond or a tree. Different animals are adapted and best suited to different habitats.
